Beginning Sewing Class

Here is your chance to learn to sew.

After you take this class, you are qualified to take The stocking class on Friday, or you can move on to Basic Sewing or other classes of your choice. You will need to sign up as soon as possible. We like to keep these classes small in order to give special attention to each student.

The object of this class is to learn how to operate your sewing machine and make a basic sewing project in order to prepare you for further sewing adventures.

PROJECT: We will be making a pillow case with a border of different fabric. Also learn how to make a ruffle.

Project supplies:

Fabric: 1 yd of cotton print fabric, 1/2 yd of coordinating color fabric

Thread: Cotton or polyester thread (color to coordinate with your fabric)

BASIC SEWING SUPPLIES: Sewing machine in good working order with Machine Manual (if you have one)

Presser Feet that came with your sewing machine

Don't forget your cord and power foot

Scissors, straight pins (we prefer glass head pins, they don't melt when ironing)

Wash away marking pen, or chalk

Seam gauge and seam ripper

Tape measure
