You will love embroidering this beautiful patriotic bench pillow. You will learn how to rehoop your designs. You can use your 6 x 10 hoop or 9 x 14 hoop.

MATERIALS LIST

Hoops:

9x14

7x12

5x7

NOTE: You must have the largest hoop size listed to complete the entire project. The other hoops are listed as options to use, to be able to use less stabilizer and to support your fabric during the embroidery process. It is recommended that you always use the smallest hoop size that fits the design.

Stabilizer:

No-Show Fusible Mesh Stabilizer (or other stabilizer of your choosing)

Tear-Away Stabilizer

Water Soluble Stabilizer (Sew and Wash)

- Fabric 1:** Background (white or cream) 1 Fat Quarter (white or cream)
- Fabric 2:** Inner Border & Applique Lettering/Star (blue) 1 Fat Eighth (blue)
- Fabrics 3-8:** Patched Borders (red, blue, white or tan) 6 Different Fat Eighths
(2 red, 2 white or tan, 2 blue)
- Fabrics 9-10:** Dimensional Pinwheels (red/blue) **(2)** 4 x 7” blocks each red/blue
- Fabrics 11-13:** Applique Flags/Star (red/blue) **(3)** 4x10” blocks each red/blue
- Fabrics 14:** Backing 1/2 yard
- Other:

For Flag Pennant Banner: 2/3-yard Medium Rick Rack

For Pinwheels: **(2)** 1/4 yard (blue/red) Mini Rick Rack

For Pinwheel Centers: 2 small Buttons

Also bring: embroidery machine with embroidery unit, embroidery thread, bobbins, applique scissors, water soluble fabric marker, pins, ruler, rotary cutter and mat (optional)
