



## May Flowers Bench Pillow

Now you can MACHINE EMBROIDER Kimberbell's popular series of interchangeable bench pillow covers! Start by making one large "bench pillow" form. Then change out a new cover for that pillow form for each season or holiday!

### What to bring:

- Embroidery Machine with embroidery unit
- Hoop: 6x10 or 9x14
- No show stabilizer, or cutaway stabilizer
- Basic sewing supplies: applique scissors, washable marking pen, ruler, rotary cutter and mat, thread

### Fabric

- **Fabric 1:** Main Background 1/3 Yard (white)
- **Fabric 2:** Inner Border 1/8 Yard (blue)
- **Fabric 3:** Outer Border 3/8 Yard (floral)
- **Fabrics 4-5:** Applique Flower Pots Scrap Fabric (brown, orange)
- **Fabrics 6-7:** Applique Flowers Scrap Fabric (pink, red)
- **Fabric 8:** Applique Leaves Scrap Fabric (green)
- **Fabric 9:** Backing 1/2 Yard
- **Other:**

1 Yard of 3/8" wide Ribbon for Center Flower (orange)

1 1/8 Yard of 3/8" wide Ribbon for 2 Small Flowers (yellow)

(7) Buttons for Center of Flowers (black or brown)

**\*Note:** If you are quilting the front of the pillow, you will also need 2/3-yard muslin AND 2/3 yard thin batting. I highly recommend quilting the pillow front.
