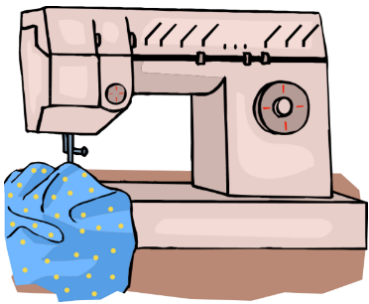
We are making this soft and comfortable quilt using flannel. Easy to make and will make a great gift for baby showers, football games, or wrap up while watching your favorite movie.

Machine in good working order
Walking, or dual feed sewing foot
scissors, thread, pins
Rotary Cutter, 24 in ruler, and 24 in cutting mat

Fabric

Flannel (do not wash)
2 ½ yds (42-44-inch-wide) of **three different colors**
(prints or solids, your choice)

What to bring for Sewing Machine Basics Class:

- Sewing machine in good working order (if your machine is having any problems, please have it repaired or serviced before class)
- Machine instruction manual and all accessories that come with your machine
- Power cord and foot pedal (gas pedal)
- Sewing supplies: 2 spools of thread (different colors), scissors, 2 empty bobbins, Machine needles, and straight pins (We have basic sewing kits for purchase here at SCI)

What to bring

- Machine in good working order, foot control, cord
- 1/2 yd cotton fabric for the outside, 1/2 yd cotton fabric for lining, 1/2 yd light or medium weight fusible interfacing, 1/3 yd cotton fabric for cuff.
- If you want to embroider, bring your stabilizer and hoop
- Ribbon to make tab for hanging the stocking
- Scissors, thread, pins
