Cost \$20

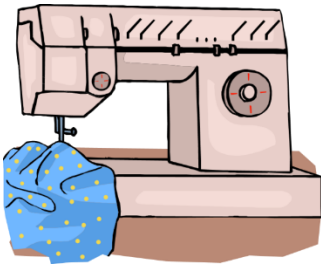
Each class is priced separately.

- Sewing supplies: 2 spools of thread (different colors), scissors, 2 empty bobbins, machine needles, and straight pins (We have basic sewing kits for purchase her at SCI)

### Techniques:

- Machine Use
- Bobbins
- Basic Sewing Terms
- Practice stitching and control

### Supplies

- Machine in good working order and instruction manual
- Power cord and foot pedal
- 2 different colored threads, bobbins, scissors, straight pins (SCI offers for purchase a sewing kit that contains basic tools)

These patterns are made for beginning sewers.



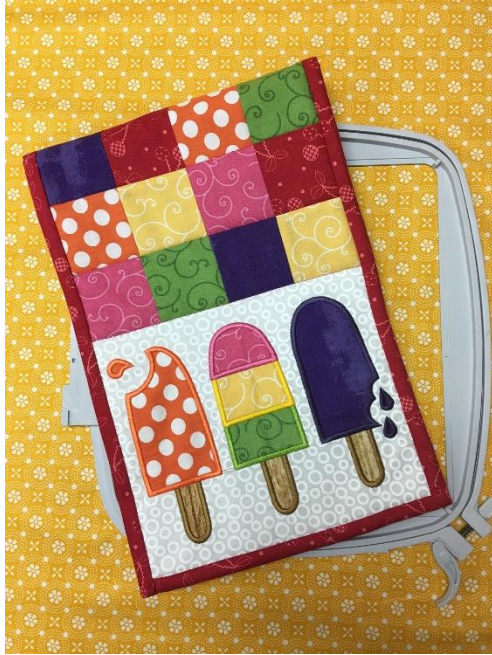
### Techniques

- Reading a pattern
- Cutting a pattern
- Sewing seams
- Making a casing with drawstring/elastic
- Machine stitch hemming

### Supplies

- Machine in good working order
- Sewing accessories: machines needles, straight pins, thread, bobbins, fabric scissors
- Pattern Mc Calls M7589 or Simplicity 1520
- Cotton fabric, elastic

### **“Pop of Summer” Table Runner**

What’s the one thing that can make a hot summer day perfect?

Definitely a popsicle on a stick! Juicy colors and appliqued popsicles make this bright table runner just as exciting as the icy treat itself. This multi-hoop project has a pieced center section and machine binding that quilters will love too.

#### **Supply List:**

- Embroidery Machine with at least a 5x7 hoop, Larger hoop (240x150 or 8x8) if you don’t want to learn multi hoop technique (Be brave learn something new)
- Embroidery Threads – orange, pink, purple, yellow, green, brown (We are using the same materials as in the picture)
- Red sewing thread
- Bobbins for embroidery and sewing
- Pins, Scissors
- Stitch in the ditch sewing foot (optional)
- ¼ inch foot (optional)
- Wash away pen

## Basic Hand Smocking

- Hand sewing needles (size 7 or 8)

- Scissors

When: June 20, 27 & July 11, 18 (4-part class)

Time: 6:00 pm – 8:30 pm

Cost: \$65

This class allows you to choose your own project (pattern), making your own fashion statement with guidance from an experienced seamstress.

### What to bring:

- Sewing Machine in good working order
- Pattern and all supplies needed for your project
- Basic sewing supplies
